Soul Training: Spiritual growth (transformation) comes when we participate with the Holy Spirit through "training our souls". We can pursue this work by engaging in practices that create space for God to do His forming work in us. Because sometimes it is hard to know where to start or it is helpful to explore new practices, we have created and curated resources to help us invest in our own spiritual formation, individually and together. As always, we invite you to do as you can, not as you can't. Consider choosing one practice to explore as you engage with God.

- **30-Day Gospel Reading Plan:** One of the best ways to get to know God is by getting to know Jesus. One of the best ways to get to know Jesus is by regularly reading the gospels. We are encouraging everyone to be intentional about how we engage with God through scripture and to move toward having a regular rhythm of engaging with God and his word. We have a guide available here.
- **Daily Audio Bible:** In about 20-30 minutes per day, you will hear the entire Bible in a year (and it's not too late to sign up)! We are making this journey together, listening to God's word independently yet encouraging each other and sharing the truths God reveals to us for the first time or in new and exciting ways. LifeGroups: If you have not yet signed up for a LifeGroup (our small groups ministry), but might be interested in the future, please let us know by <u>signing up</u>. We will keep you updated when groups are open and new groups are being formed. We plan to do this two or three times a year.

Covenant Annual Meeting: Each year, delegates from Covenant Churches across the country meet to celebrate the mission of the Covenant church, vote on the budget, make policy decisions, welcome new churches, ordain clergy and missionaries, and pray and worship together. This year, the Annual Meeting of our denomination will take place in Garden Grove, California June 28-July 1. ECC can send up to four delegates to this meeting.
